LOCAL HISTORY SEMINARS - HOUSES AND HOMES

A series of Local History seminars that began last year will be continued in 1983-84. The six seminars this year will be linked to the theme "Houses and Homes". Six speakers will talk at monthly intervals about houses and homes in Lincolnshire and the evidence which enables local historians to recreate both the internal and external details of the houses that people lived in. The talks will be followed by tea and then discussion of the photostat and duplicated material provided by the speaker. This seminar discussion was a very successful feature of last year's series and this means
